

## **FRIDAY PENANCE**

Penance, which is part of our Christian witness as we identify with Christ on the cross, focuses weekly on Friday, the day of the death of the Lord. The Bishops wish to remind the Catholics of England and Wales of this commitment as a stable part of their Catholic identity. So we have re-established the practice of abstaining from meat on Fridays. Those who cannot or choose not to eat meat as part of their normal diet are invited to abstain from some other food they normally take. This precept comes into effect on **16<sup>th</sup> September**, which marks the anniversary of Pope Benedict's visit to us.

As we are all very aware, East Africa is currently experiencing the worst drought in almost 60yrs. The scale of this disaster is outstripping all local capacity to act with the result that tens of thousands of people

are already on the move to search for water, pasture and food. Given the gravity of the situation and the urgent need to respond quickly, the UK's Disasters Emergency Committee has decided to launch an appeal. As part of this CAFOD is launching its own £5m appeal so that Catholics can choose to give directly to CAFOD. There will be a retiring collection after all weekend masses at the beginning of August.
