## **THE NEW ROMAN MISSAL – WHAT ABOUT MUSIC?**

One of the key features of the New Roman Missal is the amount of music it contains which is there both for practical use and to remind us of the integral place of music in the liturgy. The beauty and dignity of the Mass text will help create a better environment for chant and the music of the Roman Rite. More than any other change, this is the one that will lead to a general settling down at Mass so that the liturgy will be more prayerful and reflective, a time when time itself ceases and we are better able to contemplate and see into eternity. It is a fact that music makes a much larger contribution to the orientation of our mind and heart than is generally supposed. The translation of the main texts (such as the Gloria and the Sanctus) sung by the people at Mass is changing. To take account of these changes, the new music for Mass will be introduced in a few weeks.
