Next weekend the whole Church unites in an act of universal solidarity in prayer for its missionary activity and in collecting funds to support the Mission of the Church worldwide. 40% of the Church is now considered missionary. The collection after all masses next weekend **20th/21st October**, supports the local Church where it is too young, weak or vulnerable to be self-sufficient, and is one of three universal mandatory collections alongside the Holy Places on Good Friday and Peter's Pence.
