PERSECUTION STUDY DAY

Saturday 5th July at Truro Methodist Church - 10.00am until 4.30pm

The Church worldwide is possibly facing its greatest crisis for hundreds of years. The Christians in Iraq, for example, are now facing annihilation. Only deeply committed prayer involving many Christians can save them but it is necessary to know what is going on and to care. Those who are involved - including Pope Francis - believe that there is a clear eschatological component to this persecution and that the apathetic West is coming under judgement just as surely as the suffering Christians overseas. There will be number of major speakers at the study day who have first hand experience, including Patrick Sookhdeo who advises our own and the American governments, NATO, Vladimir Putin, General Sisi etc. He is regularly in countries such as Syria, Iraq, Pakistan and Nigeria and knows many of the Muslim leaders.
