THE EBOLA CRISIS

CAFOD, alongside its Church partners, is scaling up its response to the continuing crisis in West Africa. It is working with priests and imams to spread the word about hand-washing and safe sanitation, and to distribute hygiene kits. Priests and communities are being trained in how to carry out safe burials and CAFOD is providing care and emotional support to families who have lost loved ones. As the spread of Ebola widens, the daily provision of food is becoming more difficult and CAFOD is planning to work in Sierra Leone and Liberia to make sure vulnerable families have enough food. CAFOD is very grateful for the generosity shown by parish communities for the recent Harvest Fast Day and is not asking parishes to hold a special collection. However it would be grateful for our faithful and continuing prayers for the communities affected by Ebola and for those who are working so courageously to relieve the suffering in West Africa.
