WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

This Sunday is World Mission Day, the day which unites Catholics all over the world in prayer, celebration and care for the family of the church. This year Missio's World Mission Sunday campaign focuses on the needs of the 100,000 displaced people in northern Myanmar (formerly known as Burma) Bishop Francis of Myitkyina diocese is running a health clinic, schools and shelters for hundreds of people in his community who have been forced to leave their homes because of the violent civil war in their State. On account of the very recent CAFOD Harvest Collection, it has been decided to delay the collection for World Mission Sunday until the weekend of **1st/2nd November** when there will be a retiring collection after all masses.
