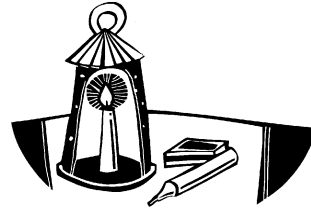
PARISH PILGRIMAGE MEETING
