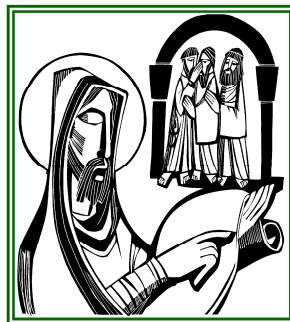

### **SUMMER SCHOOL AT BUCKFAST ABBEY**

The School of the Annunciation - '*Catholic Introduction to Scripture*'  
**Thursday 30th July - Sunday 2nd August 2015.**

*'The study of the sacred Scriptures must be a door opened to every believer. It is essential that the revealed word radically enriches our catechesis and all our efforts to pass on the faith'* Pope Francis, *Evangelii Gaudium*.

The summer school will focus on three areas: The senses and meaning of Sacred Scripture according to the teaching and vision of the Catechism of the Catholic Church: Approaching the New Testament through original languages: The Catholic approach to New Testament interpretation. The cost, including full board and lodging at Buckfast Abbey is £325, or £60 per day (including refreshments and lunch). There is a non refundable registration fee payable upon your application. The summer school begins at 5.30pm on 30th July and ends at lunch time on Sunday 2nd August.
