PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND

The cost will be approximately between £1,950 and £2,500, depending on the length of the pilgrimage, 10 or 14 days, and whether a visit to Jordan is included. The cost is all inclusive, covering travel, a good standard of hotel accommodation, all meals, entry fees to all holy sites etc - certainly good value for money! It has to be mentioned that it is necessary to have reasonable mobility and physical fitness as a full programme is offered and there is a degree of walking involved.
