PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND

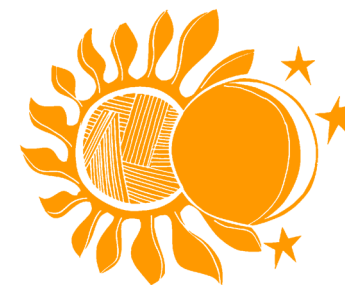
