This study day is a rare opportunity to hear first-hand accounts of the privations, threats and atrocities that face Christians in many parts of the world today. The speakers include Baroness Caroline Cox who will speak about the worsening persecution in Sudan, Nigeria and sub-Sahara Africa as well as South East Asia, Wilson Chowdhry of the British Pakistani Christian Association and Jane Bicknell of World Watch Monitor who will talk about the little reported but significant problem of persecution and assassination of Christians by drug barons in Central and Southern Americas.
