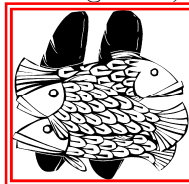

FEAST OF SAINT BONIFACE

Next weekend, **4th/ 5th June** we celebrate the Feast of St Boniface, the patron

saint of our Diocese. To reflect this, the readings for the weekend masses will be changed from those prescribed in the missal for 10th Sunday in Ordinary time. 1ST SATURDAY DEVOTIONS

The next '1st Saturday Devotion', *Saturday 4th June at 5.00pm*, consists of one Rosary, 15 mins meditation on the Mysteries of the Rosary and Confession. The 1st Saturday devotion was a request from Mother Mary to Sr. Lucia (one of the three children who Mother Mary appeared to at Fatima, Portugal). Our Lady said "I promise to assist at the moment of death, with all the Graces necessary for salvation, all those who, on the 1st Saturday of five consecutive months shall receive the sacrament of confession, receive Holy Communion, recite five decades of the Rosary, and keep me company for fifteen minutes while meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, with the intention of making reparation to my Immaculate Heart". The Confession can be heard on the day, eight days prior or eight days after the first Saturday. Communion can be received at the 6pm Mass.

DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO CREDITON

Sunday 5th June: Solemnity of St. Boniface

Pope Francis has stressed that pilgrimage has a special place in this Holy Year of Mercy. During the year, we have various opportunities to take this up, including a special Diocesan Pilgrimage to Crediton, the birthplace of Saint Boniface. Sung Vespers and Solemn Benediction will be celebrated at St. Boniface Church at 4.00pm, followed by a Solemn Procession to the statue of St. Boniface. After prayers at the statue there will be a final blessing by Bishop Mark, returning to St Boniface Church for afternoon tea. The town is also celebrating with a Flower Festival at Holy Cross Church, a St Boniface Walk commencing at 2pm and a re-enactment of the story of St Boniface below the statue in Newcombes Meadow at 3pm.

QUIZ NIGHT AND FISH & CHIP SUPPER
