### **LAMPEDUSA CROSS WALK OF WITNESS**

The Diocese, together with CAFOD, the Anglican Diocese of Exeter and others, are organising a Walk of Witness in solidarity with those people who have been forced to become refugees because of war, climate change, exploitation and persecution. The walk will be with the South-West's own 'Lampedusa Cross', made from salvaged pieces of boats wrecked in making their way to Europe. The Walk will take place on Saturday morning, **19th November** from Plymouth City Centre Piazza, Armada Way at 10.00am to the Cathedral where Bishop Mark will receive the cross.
