On this national Holocaust Memorial Day, the victims of the Nazi Holocaust and of subsequent genocide in Cambodia (1975 - 1979), Rwanda (1994), Bosnia (1995), Darfur (to the present day from 2003) and all those currently suffering were specially remembered. ### **NEW DIOCESAN CERTIFICATE**

Bishop Mark has endorsed a study course (Foundations of the Faith for the New Evangelisation) offered by the School of the Annunciation, delivered online with six study days at Buckfast Abbey, which is aimed at parish level for any and all who would like to deepen their understanding of the Faith. Useful for parish evangelisation teams, for parents and for catechists, the course runs for eighteen months, and the Bishop will issue diocesan certificates for those who complete it. The initial cost of the course is £334 for nine months, plus a single registration fee of £50. Fuller details of the content of the course are available on the School's website, [schooloftheannunciation.com](http://schooloftheannunciation.com). The course begins with a study day at Buckfast on *Saturday 25th February*, and applications need to be in by *Friday 10th February*. Application forms are available on the table in the Narthex or can be downloaded from the website.
