### **'LET US PRAY'**

Next **Sunday 28th May** there is an opportunities to join in prayer with our fellow Christians from other traditions. Churches Together in Cornwall are holding an Evening of Prayer in Truro Cathedral, commencing at **5.00pm**. This event has been planned as part of the call to the nation to ten days of prayer from the Archbishop of Canterbury and the leaders of many of the nation's Christian traditions. It centres around the theme "Thy Kingdom Come", and opens with Choral Evensong and concludes with a time of Taizé Worship at 8.30pm. The Anglican Bishop of St Germans writes: *"'Thy kingdom come' is at the heart of the prayer Jesus taught his disciples and this prayer is not just for us, but for his world. His heart is especially for those who do not yet know him. As we come together with Christians around Cornwall and around the country let's focus on those who still need to discover the love of God in Jesus"*.
