EASTER BAPTISMAL WATER

At Easter the font is solemnly blessed, providing water for baptism, You may wish to bring a small container to take home some of the blessed water from the font. You can use the holy water to bless your home and family during Eastertide. Say the 'Our Father' together as you sprinkle the family and home, and use a simple form of blessing, for example: "*Blessed are you, God our Father, bless our family and home this Eastertide as we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit for ever and ever*".

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

This **Sunday 22nd April** the Church celebrates the call to the priesthood and consecrated life. On this one Sunday we pray especially for those God is calling to be consecrated or to be ordained as priests and deacons. The people God calls to these ways of life are ordinary people called to make visible the extra dimensions of ordinary life. ROSARY ON THE COAST - Charlestown

Sunday 29th April at 3.00pm has been chosen as a launch date for 'Rosary on the Coast' in the British Isles. This is a day of Pilgrimage and Prayer for the re-flourishing of our Faith, for the grace to build a culture of Life, and for true Peace to reign in the hearts of all peoples and nations. As a parish, we are planning to hold a public praying of the Rosary event on Charlestown harbour, by the Harbourmaster's Office, with the Ordinariate Group at 3.00pm.

Rosary on the Coast - Fowey

Fr. Robbie Low will lead a group walking and praying the Rosary from Fowey Retreat House to Polridmouth Bay and back to Fowey via Coombe on the coastal path. This is a challenging walk (2 hours + approx). The group will leave the Retreat (17 Lankelly Lane) at 1.00pm. Please bring a packed lunch and sturdy footwear. There will be tea and cake at the Retreat afterwards. If you are not able to do the walk there will be an opportunity to stay at the Retreat and use the garden or the Chapel to join in the Rosary prayer. It is best to park either on the main road before turning up Lankelly Lane or go to the end of Lankelly Lane and park there near the rugby club and walk back. All are welcome but if you are planning to come on the Rosary walk could you please let the Parish Office know (01726 73838) so that numbers can be passed on to Fr Robbie and Sara for the catering.
