PRAYER VIGIL FOR THE CARE OF CREATION - 1st September

In 2015 Pope Francis declared that the 1st September should be annually recognised as the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. He said, "*The annual World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation offers to individual believers and to the community a precious opportunity to renew our personal participation in this vocation as custodians of creation, raising to God our thanks for the marvellous works that He has entrusted to our care, invoking his help for the protection of creation and his mercy for the sins committed against the world in which we live.*"

This year it is planned to hold a prayer vigil at St Augustine's on **Saturday 1st**

September from 11 a.m. until 12 noon. There will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament during this time and it will conclude with the Angelus and Benediction. Parishioners do not need to attend for the whole hour and are more than welcome just to pop in for 5 or 10 minutes or however long they can spare. The children of the parish are invited to write a prayer for the vigil. If you would like your child to contribute, please take one of the prepared sheets from brown envelope on the small table in the Narthex and when complete, place it in the 'prayer collection box' on that table.
