### **NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC PILGRIMAGE & CONGRESS (Adoremus)**

***'I am the Bread of Life' in Liverpool, 7th-9th September 2018***

The Catholic Bishop's Conference of England and Wales is holding the first Eucharistic Congress since 1908. The focus of the Congress is Eucharistic Adoration. Because Adoration of the Eucharist deepens our relationship with Christ, it enables us to be more effective disciples who will be better able to lead others to the life of the Church that has the Eucharist at its heart. The main part of the event will take place at the Liverpool Echo Arena on Saturday 8th September and St Augustine's has been allocated 3 delegate places. One parishioner has already requested a place and if you would like one of the other 2 places available please let Fr Peter know as soon as possible. The cost of a place is £40 per delegate per day. A financial contribution from the parish towards the cost of the weekend will be available if needed.
